- Go to [www.harvardpubliclibrary.org](http://www.harvardpubliclibrary.org) and click on the Teens link at the top of the page.
- Next, click on the Teen Summer Reading 2021 link.
- The first time you log in, you will need to create a username and password.
- Once you have signed in, you can write book reviews or complete activity challenges.
- **Each review or activity you complete will earn you 1 ticket in the Teen End of Summer Reading Raffle.** You can even choose which of the 3 prizes you want your ticket to count for.

**If you complete 3 reviews, you will earn a bag of small prizes and candy.**

**If you complete 5 reviews, you will earn a book from the Pick-a-Book cart.**

**Activity Badges:** To earn online activity badges, log in to your online summer reading account and click the **Badges** tab, and then the **Activity Badges** tab. Complete the challenges listed there to earn entries in the Teen End of Summer Reading Raffle Drawing.

**Book Reviews:** You can read and review any book from anywhere-it doesn't have to be something that you've checked out of the library. You may include your required summer reading, or listening to an audiobook.

To enter a book review, log in to the Teen Summer Reading program and click the **Badges** tab. Then, select the **Review Badges** tab to write a book review. Write a thoughtful, substantive review: tell us about the book, what you liked, and what you didn't like, questions you had, etc. Book reviews will be posted (anonymously) in the Teen Room as suggestions for other teens to read or not read!
