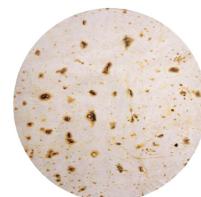

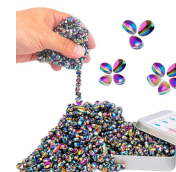

ONLINE SUMMER READING PROGRAM

How do I sign up for the online Teen Summer Reading program?

- Scan the QR Code.
- Scroll down to select **Teen Summer Reading 2026**.
- Register- or, if you did summer reading last year, you can sign in using last year's username and password.
- Begin your summer reading AFTER school gets out on **June 18th**.
- Log your hours, write book reviews or participate in activity challenges to earn tickets.
- You can then put your tickets toward any prize you want. You can even move your tickets around until summer reading ends on **August 13th**.

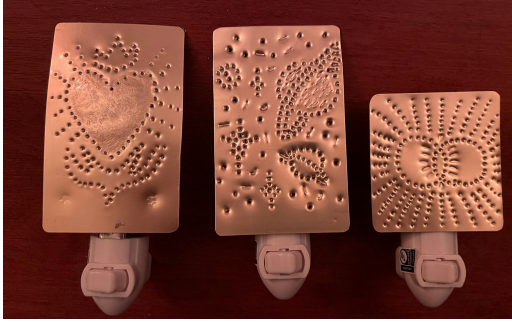

Teams are encouraged to bring any other decorating items or decorating ingredients they would like to use.

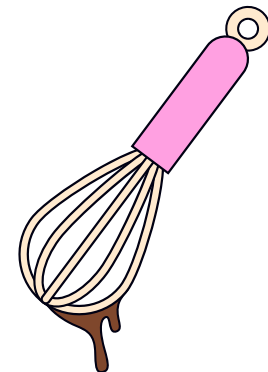
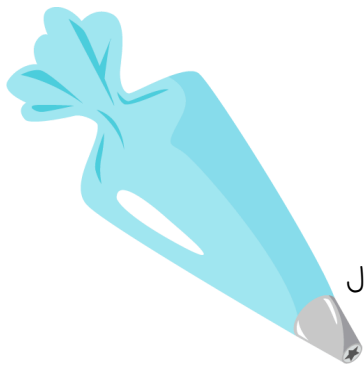

Create your own jewelry or coasters using UV Resin, dried flowers, glitter, and more!

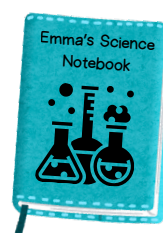

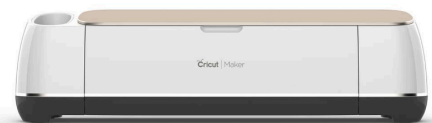


Cricut Vinyl Notebooks & Journals

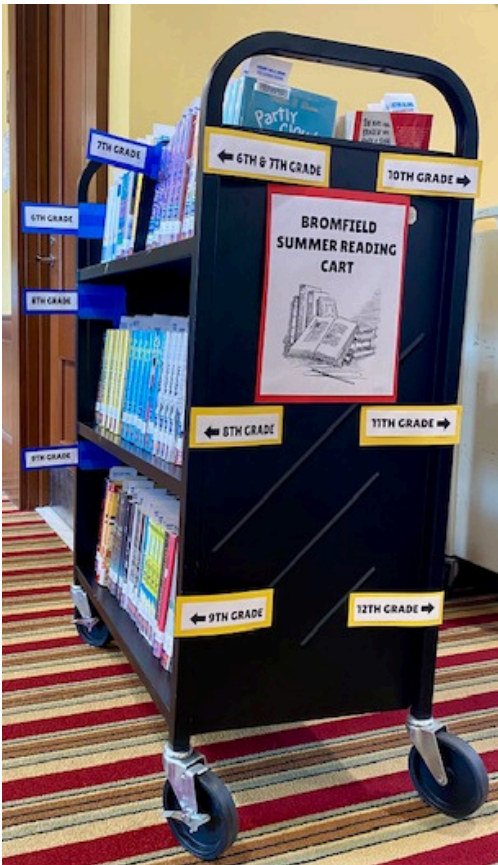
