Spring session runs through May 15 This 20 to 30 minute storytime includes songs and fingerplays, simple stories, feltboard stories, and phonemic awareness activities appropriate for children aged 2 & 3 years old and their caregivers (older siblings are also welcome). Our phonemic awareness activities will focus on learning and practicing some consonant sounds, reviewing the short vowel sounds, and learning to put sounds together to make simple words.

Registration is required for the spring session. Enrollment is limited to 10 children and their caregivers. <u>Register here.</u>

Art & Stories for 4's & 5's Ages 4 & 5 and up Mondays at 1:30 PM

Spring session runs through May 13

This 30 to 45 minute program, appropriate for children ages 4 to 7, begins with a few longer picturebook stories and phonemic awareness activities, then ends with a process art project that encourages preschoolers to explore art materials in an open-ended, creative manner.

Make sure to wear clothes that can get messy! Our phonemic awareness activities will focus on learning and practicing some consonant sounds, reviewing the short vowel sounds, and learning to put sounds together to make simple words.

Registration is required for the spring session. Enrollment is limited to 12 children. Register here.
