**3pm-4pm in Volunteers Hall**

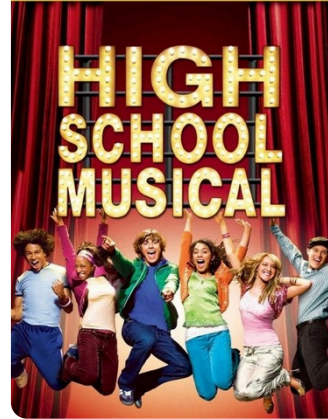
Want to help the library shape collections and programs for teens?
