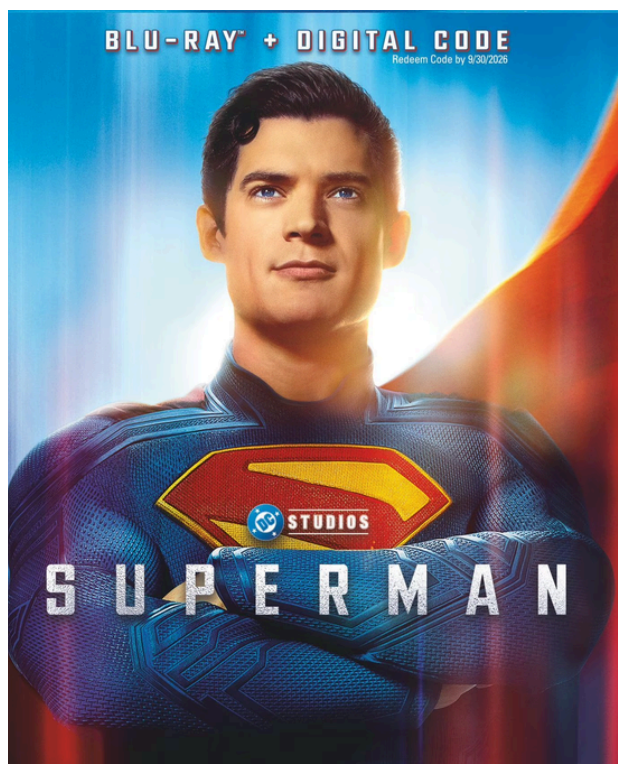

Our meetings will take place on:

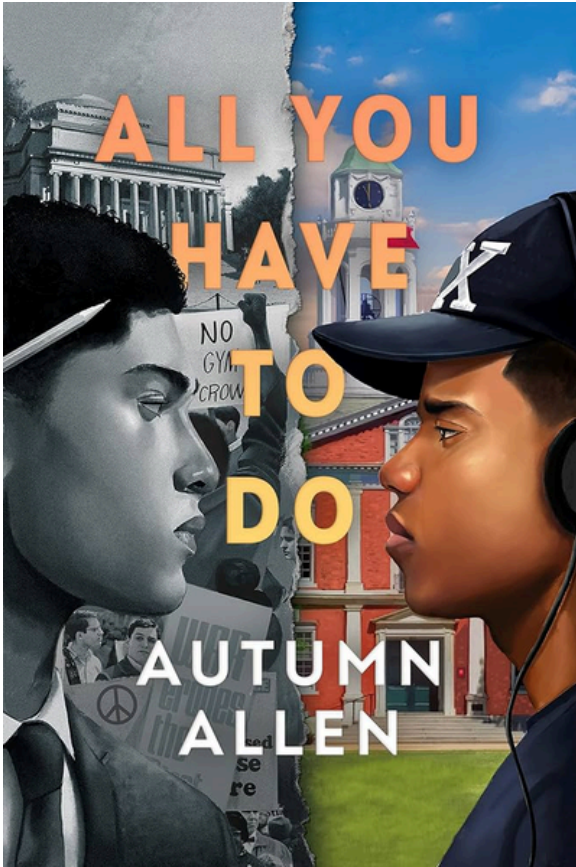

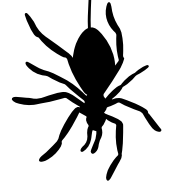

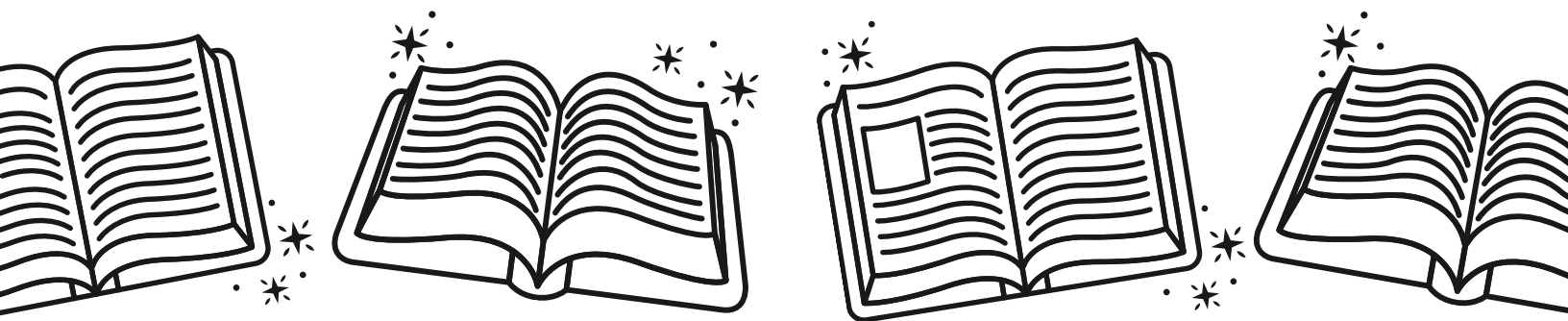
