The first time you log in, you will need to create a username and password. Once you have signed in, you can write book reviews or complete activity challenges. Each review you submit, or activity you complete, will count as one entry in the Teen End of Summer Reading Raffle.

BOOK REVIEWS:

Start your summer reading *after* you get out of school on June 22nd. You can read and review any book from anywhere-it doesn't have to be something that you've checked out of the library. You may include your required summer reading, or listening to an audiobook.

To enter a book review, log in to the Teen Summer Reading program and click the **BADGES** tab. Then, select **REVIEW BADGES**. Write a thoughtful, substantive review: tell us about the book, what you liked, and what you didn't like, questions you had, etc. Book reviews will be posted (anonymously) in the Teen Room as suggestions for other teens to read or not read!

To earn online activity badges, log in to your online summer reading account and click the ACTIVITIES tab. Complete the challenges listed there to earn entries in the Teen End of Summer Reading Raffle Drawing.
