



Mango Languages App Instructions for Android, Apple & Kindle Fire Devices


Always wanted to learn a new language? With the Mango Languages Library Edition App and your Harvard Public Library card, you can get free access to over 72 foreign language courses, 19 English courses taught in the user's native language and 36 specialty courses. Download the App and start learning today!

Create a Mango Languages Account

1. Go to www.harvardpubliclibrary.org and click on the **Resources & Research**.
2. Next click on **eLearning**.
3. Scroll down until you see the Mango Languages icon and click on it. Don't have a profile?  ?
4. To create a log in profile in the upper right hand corner, click the **Sign Up** button.
5. Select the language you would like to start learning. You can try as many languages as you want after you finish creating your profile.

Choose one of over 70 language courses.

Before you create a profile, please select a language.



6. Fill in the required information and click the **Create Free Profile** button. You will then be asked to agree to a **Data Consent Form**.




7. After you have created your profile, link it to your Harvard Public Library card.

In the upper right hand corner, hover over your name where it says **Edit your profile**. In the box that appears, click **Settings**.



On the left hand side of the screen find and click on **Organizations**. Then click **Link an Account**.

Now search for the Harvard Public Library. Type in Harvard Public Library or 01451. Select **Harvard Public Library** from the list, and click **Connect**.

Now, enter your library card number. After you have entered your library card number correctly, click the Connect button.

If you have entered your information correctly, you will see the message Your profile is now linked. Continue learning by clicking the **Start Using Mango** button.

Start Using Mango

Download the Mango Languages App



1. Go to the App store on your device and download the **Mango Languages** app.
2. Open the app and **Log in** using the credentials you used to create your Mango account.
3. The app will open to the course listing page of the language you selected when creating your account. You may start from there, or tap **Learn** to go back to the **Your Languages** page.
4. To find a new course, tap **Add a Language** (Apple devices) OR **Add More Courses** (Android and Kindle devices).
5. The languages are organized by **Popular Languages & All Languages**. Tap on the language you are interested in learning.
6. You will be taken to a course listing page. Select the language course you would like to take, and get started!
7. Mango will automatically bookmark your progress when you close the app.
