



hoopla Roku Instructions

hoopla account

If you do not have a **hoopla** account go to **www.hoopladigital.com/home** to register.

You will need to provide an e-mail address, create a password, and have your Harvard Public Library card number ready. (Enter the number with no spaces and if it begins with a "D" use a capital D).

Getting Started

Add the hoopla Roku channel

- 1. From the home screen, navigate to Streaming Channels. In Streaming Channels, go to "Search Channels" and search for "hoopla."
- 2. Click to add the **hoopla** channel.

Sync your hoopla account with your hoopla Roku channel

- 1. Once the channel is added on your Roku device, select it from your channels.
- At the top of the welcome screen a 4-digit code is displayed. On another device, log into hoopla's website (www.hoopladigital.com) using a mobile or desktop browser, and visit https://www.hoopladigital.com/link.
- 3. Enter the 4-digit code from your TV screen and in a few seconds you are up and running on the hoopla Roku channel. You can enjoy playing currently borrowed movies and television episodes.

Frequently Asked Questions

What versions of Roku devices are supported?

hoopla offers a Roku channel for devices running 7.6.3 and higher.

What features does the Roku channel have?

hoopla currently has the following feature:

• Stream currently borrowed movies and television.

Support for browsing and borrowing is coming soon.

How do I turn on closed captions on the Roku channel?

- 1. Start your video.
- 2. Using your remote, hit the option button (*).
- 3. Use your up or down arrow until you highlight the closed captioning option.
- 4. Use your left or right arrow until you highlight the always on option.
- 5. Hit the OK button and your subtitles will display on screen.

How many items may I borrow from hoopla per month?

You may borrow 8 items per month. The borrowing limits reset on the first of each calendar month.

How long can I borrow items for?

Television and movies titles lend for 3 days.

How do I access eBooks, Music and Audiobooks on hoopla or use my phone or tablet?

There is a **hoopla** App for Android, Apple and Kindle Fire devices. You may also use your PC or MacBook.
